ONGOING SERVICES

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- The **Atlanta Community Food Bank** connects public benefits to families and individuals who qualify through its **Benefits Outreach Program**, helping them secure assistance with food, healthcare, childcare and more. - The **Atlanta COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance Program**, coordinated through the **United Way of Greater Atlanta** and **City of Atlanta**, provides funds to City of Atlanta residents to cover past due rent, utilities, and move-in deposits as a result of impending eviction. - **Aunt Bertha** is a **Social Care Network** that connects people seeking help with verified social care providers that serve them. Thousands of nonprofits and social care providers serve their communities. But for most people, navigating the system to get help has been difficult, time consuming, and frustrating. - **Empowerline** provides a front desk for people who need help navigating life changes and surprise obstacles in their homes, with their health, and in their communities. The service, powered by the **Aging and Independent Services Group** of the Atlanta Regional Commission, helps connect people with private and publicly funded resources from more than 26,000 community based providers. Empowerline is part of **Georgia's Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC) network**, a No Wrong Door access point for information requests and assistance. - The **Georgia Department of Community Affairs** administers the **State of Georgia Rental Assistance Program (GRA)**. The State of Georgia received \$989 million from U.S. Treasury's Federal Emergency Rental Assistance Program to provide relief to individuals, families, and landlords whose finances have been negatively impacted since March 13, 2020, the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. The funds will be used for rental and utility payments, including other associated expenses. The Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) administers this program which opened in March 2021. The money is distributed directly to landlords and service providers, where applicable, and eligible applicants will receive up to 18 months of payment relief. Individuals must qualify for unemployment or have experienced a financial hardship since March 13, 2020; demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability; and have household income at or below 80 percent of the area median income (AMI).
